## My Morning Prayer

## Applying God's Word:

(Col 3:16 NIV) Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.

(Heb 4:12 KJV) For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

(John 15:7 KJV) If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

(Deu 4:9 NIV) Only be careful, and watch yourselves closely so that you do not forget the things your eyes have seen or let them slip from your heart as long as you live. Teach them to your children and to their children after them.

(Deu 11:18-19 NIV) Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. {19} Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

(Deu 6:6-7 NKJV) And these words, which I command you this day, shall be in your heart: {7} And you shall teach them diligently unto your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when thou lie down, and when thou rise up.

## My Prayer:

(Psalm 119:11) I will **hide your Word in my heart**, Lord, that I might not sin against you. (Proverbs 4:20-22) **I will attend to your words**; I will incline my ears unto your sayings; I will not let them depart from my eyes; I will keep them in the midst of my heart. For they are life to those of us who find them and health to all our flesh.

(Lam. 3:22)I thank you, Lord, that **your mercies are new every morning** and (Psalms 68:19) **that you daily "load me down"** with benefits.

(Psalms 103:1) Bless the Lord, O my soul, and **forget not all His benefits**. I thank you, Lord, that you have forgiven all my iniquities, you have healed all my diseases, you have redeemed my life from destruction, you have crowned me with lovingkindness and tender mercies, and that you even satisfy my mouth with good things so my youth is renewed as the eagle.

(Jer. 29:11) I thank you, Lord, that your plans for me are **plans for good** and not for evil that I might have a future and a hope. (IIIJohn v.2) And **that you wish above all things** that I may prosper and be in health even as my soul prospers. (Col. 1:13) For **you have delivered me from the power of darkness** and have translated me into

the kingdom of your dear Son, (Heb. 10:14) whose **one offering has made me forever perfect** in your sight.

(Psalm 91: 8-11) **Destruction shall not come near me**; no evil shall befall me, no plague shall come nigh my dwelling because I have made you my refuge, my habitation and you have given your angels charge over me to keep me in all my ways. (Psalm 34:19) Though **many be the afflictions of the righteous**, you deliver me out of them all, (I Peter 5:7) for **you are always thinking of me** and watching everything that concerns me. (1 Cor. 10:13) You never allow any trial to come my way that is beyond my ability, but with every trial **you provide a way of escape** that I might be able to stand up under it.

(Luke 10:19) You have even **given me authority to tread** upon the serpent and the scorpion and over all the power of the enemy and nothing shall by any means harm me, (II Cor. 10:4) And the **weapons of my warfare** are not carnal but mighty through you to the pulling down of strongholds, casting down imaginations and every high thing that exalts itself against what I know about you, Lord.

(Rom. 8:1) Thank you that **there is therefore now no condemnation** toward me because I am in Christ Jesus, that I have been set free from the law of sin and death. (Gal. 3:13) Thank you, Jesus, for **redeeming me from the curse of the Law**, that the blessing of Abraham might come upon me and overtake me: (Deut. 28:1) that I might be **blessed when I come in** and blessed when I go out; that I might be the head and not the tail, above and not beneath; that you may bless everything I set my hand to and make me "plenteous in goods"; that when my enemy comes out against me one way, he will flee before me seven ways (I John 4:4) for **greater is He** that is in me, than he that is in the world.

(Psalms 31: 1-8, 15-16, 19-24) Lord I trust in you alone. Don't let my enemy defeat me. Thank you for rescuing me because you are the God who always does what is right. Thank you for answering quickly when I cry to you; for bending low and hearing my whispered plea. (Psalm 91:14-15) Because I have set my love upon YOU, therefore YOU will deliver me; YOU will set me on high because I have known YOUR name. I shall call upon YOU, and YOU will answer me. YOU will be with me in trouble. YOU will deliver me and honor me. Be for me a great rock of safety from my foe. Yes, you are my Rock and my Fortress. Honor your name by leading me out of this peril. Pull me from the trap my enemy has set for me. For you alone are strong enough; into your hand I commit my spirit.

You lead me in paths of righteousness for your name sake. Yes, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil for you are with me.
